## **CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO DEVELOP VISUAL DISTRICT PROFILES**

### **1. INTRODUCTION:**

The Advocates' Coalition for Development and Environment (ACODE) under its Center for Budget and Economic Governance (CBEG) promotes budget transparency among other things. As part of this objective, the Center is interested in producing simplified visual district profiles for 35 districts across Uganda. The profiles utilize budget information for FY 2019/20 (including budget allocations and budget performance for FY 2018/19) and performance of districts in the Local Government Performance Assessment FY 2018/19 by the Office of the Prime Minister. The profiles will target persons with little reading abilities at the grassroots level. ACODE is desirous of enlisting the services of a programmer to create district profiles for 35 districts including, Kabale, Kisoro, Amuria, Nakapiripiriti, Masindi, Apac, Kaliro, Amuru, Mpigi, Ntungamo, Budada, Agago, Luwero, Lwengo, Tororo, Hoima, Soroti, Buliisa, Rukungiri, Moroto, Kamuli, Gulu, Mukono, Kanungu, Nebbi, Jinja, Nwoya, Wakiso, Mbarara, Arua, Mbale, Lira, Luwero, Sheema and Kabarole.

### **2. SCOPE:**

The scope of work will include, but not limited to:

- a) Compilation of budget and performance assessment on the districts as indicated above
- b) Designing of pictorial representation of the socio economic data and information on the districts

### **3. EXPECTED OUTPUTS FOR THE PROGRAMMER:**

The programmer is expected to produce;  
Thirty five (35) district profiles.

### **4. TIME FRAME:**

The tasks to be performed and the outputs to be delivered under the assignment shall be completed within a period of two weeks (5) from signing of the contract case not later than 30th November 2019.
